


Pierce County Fire District 23 Board of Commissioners' Regular Meeting July 10, 2023


Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as written. The secretary gave the financial report, listing investments and cash on hand. The Chief read his report.



- Just broke our all time calls for any month, previous record was August 2021 at 58.
- The old month record for July was 53.

- MORA call volume up significantly this month. Assisted with MCI and 3 Airlift pts.
- Airlifted two MRNP pt this month twice in one day, three in a week.
- Fire Academy moving well with recruits, approaching the end of the academy early august.

- Variable message trailer delivered, insurance and licensing. Deployed at the end of the month. Very positive comments from several locals who have stopped me and said thanks.
- Chief vehicle has arrived in the state, outfitting starting.
